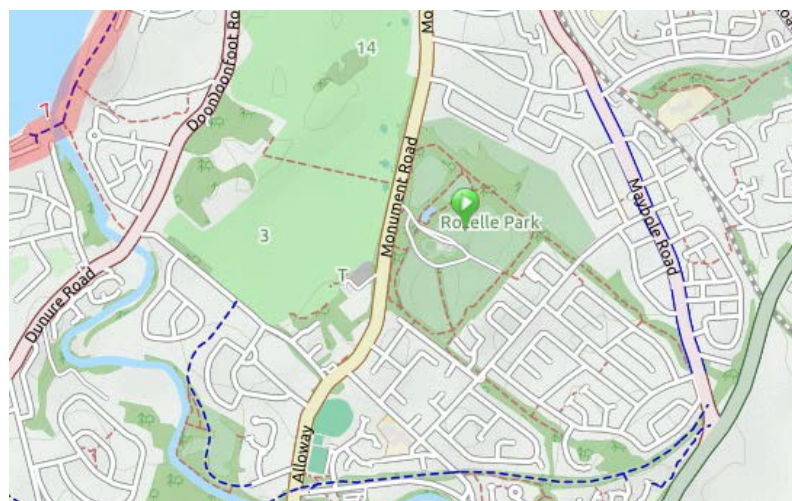

* Due to British Cycling rules on the max duration young riders can race, Youth riders (u16) will receive their finish flag after 30 minutes, and junior riders after 40 mins. Riders in these categories will be awarded their finishing place based on their position in the field at the time of them passing the flag

Winners will be invited for a podium photo immediately after crossing the line.

Where?

Our Summer Cross event takes place at Rozelle Park in the centre of Ayr. We have access to changing facilities including toilets at the Sports Pavilion within the park, staffed by South Ayrshire Council.



Car Parking

Registration

U12 fun ride

Numbers can be collected from the gazebo at the start / finish line. Numbers should be pinned on the front of the rider or the front of their bike

Open race, try-cross and SDS Cycling

Sign on will take place by the gazebo at the start / finish line. Numbers should be pinned to the rear of the jersey.

Course practice

There will be sufficient time for all riders to complete a course practice and familiarisation lap immediately before your event. Please **do not** arrive early to ride the course as we treat each field as a bubble to reduce contact.

Pits

Due to the short course and summer conditions of the event, there will be no pits at this event.

Courses 2: SDS Cycling event 2, Try-Cross and Open Race



- The Under 12 'Fun-Ride' is a free-to-enter event, non-competitive activity to experience cyclocross.
- All registration must be complete online via eventbrite in advance of the event.
- Responsible adults should be with their children at all times, except during the event, when they must wait in proximity to the start / finish area.
- The course does not feature significant elevation, but due to the changes in surface and terrain all participants should be able to confidently ride a two-wheel pedal bike, without assistance.
