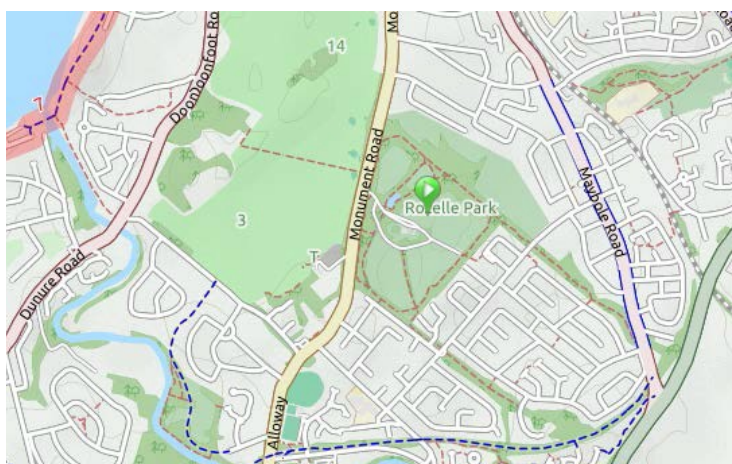

#### Where?

Our Summer Cross event takes place at Rozelle Park in the centre of Ayr. We have access to changing facilities including toilets at the Sports Pavilion within the park, staffed by South Ayrshire Council.



## Car Parking

- **ALL riders** should use the convenient and accessible on-street car parking on **Laughlanglen Road, Ayr, KA7 4QL** (Parking with the park is restricted to event officials)



The park is open to the public so please show due care and consideration when preparing for the event.

## Registration

### *U12 fun ride*

Numbers can be collected from the gazebo at the start / finish line. Numbers should be pinned on the front of the rider or the front of their bike

### *Adult Try Cross*

Numbers can be collected from the gazebo at the start / finish line. Numbers should be pinned on the front of the rider or the front of their bike. This is a non-competitive activity – riders have the chance to complete as many laps as they wish, and are able, during 20 minutes. This event is aimed at people who can cycle, but are new to cycle sport! Any bike will a bit of grip (Mtb, Hybrid, Gravel or Cross) will do!

*If you are a regular club rider, or own a wardrobe full of lycra, the Super Quaich is for you!*

### *Open race and SDS Cycling*

Sign on will take place by the gazebo at the start / finish line. Numbers should be pinned to the rear of the jersey.

## Course practice

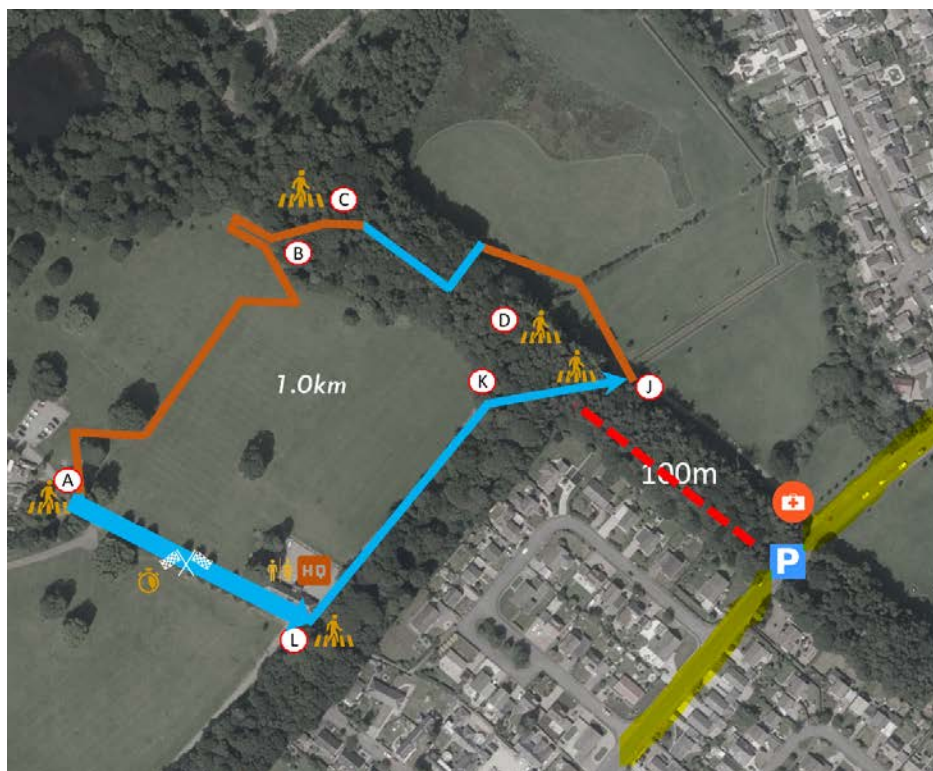

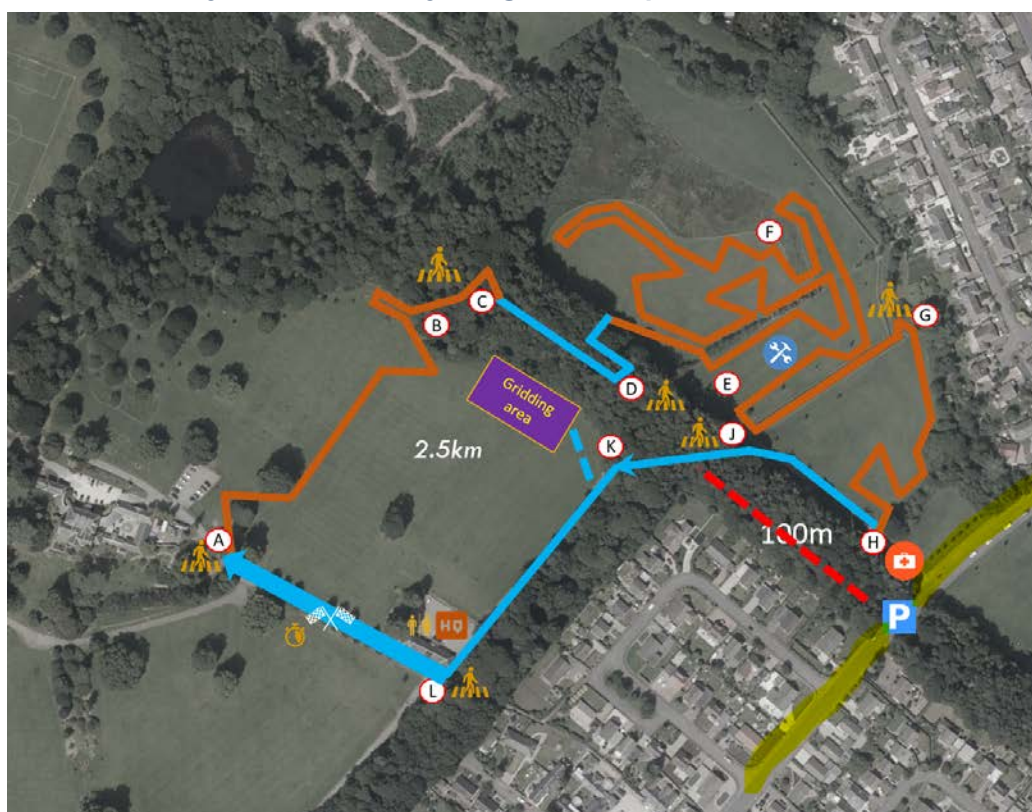

## Fun Ride

- The Under 12 'Fun-Ride' is a free-to-enter event, non-competitive activity to experience cyclocross. Riders can complete as many laps of our circuit as they wish, and are able, in 15 minutes.
- All registration must be complete online via [eventbrite](https://www.eventbrite.com) in advance of the event.
- Responsible adults should be with their children at all times, except during the event, when they must wait in proximity to the start / finish area.
- The course does not feature significant elevation, but due to the changes in surface and terrain all participants should be able to confidently ride a two-wheel pedal bike, without assistance.
